



MDS Updates Including PDPM Presented by Myers & Stauffer

October 23-24 in Bossier City

The Louisiana Nursing Home Association (LNHA) invites long-term care nursing facility staff to attend a seminar presented by Myers and Stauffer on October 23-24, 2019, at the [Hilton Garden Inn Bossier City](#). This seminar will cover all MDS coding items covered in all six chapters of the Resident Assessment Instrument (RAI) Manual. Emphasis will be placed on the new and retired MDS items implemented by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) on October 1, 2019. Additional time will be dedicated to Chapter 6 of the RAI manual reviewing the Patient-Driven Payment Model (PDPM) reimbursement model applicable to the Medicare Part A stay beginning October 1, 2019.

Seminar Objectives

- Review the additional new MDS items to be implemented October 1, 2019
- Comprehend the Rule of 3 when scoring activities of daily living
- Understand the activity functional score
- Gain a broad understanding of the new PDPM Medicare PPS reimbursement system
